

How to Set Up Hoopla on Your TV – Step-by-Step Guide

Requirements to get started

- TV turned on and connected to an account using your email.
- Wi-Fi or Ethernet connected to Television.
- TV Updated to the latest system version according to your brand.

Step 1 – Create a hoopla account

- Create a hoopla account on your phone or tablet via the app from the google play store or apple play, or go on a computer to www.hoopladigital.com and create an account with an email, password, library card number, and 4-digit PIN.

Step 2 – Download the Hoopla App on your TV

- Turn your TV on and navigate to your HOME page. You can do this by locating the home button on your remote or by hitting the back arrow on the left of your remote if you are already in an app or watching content.
- Once on the home screen, look for the app menu. This generally appears as a list of apps. Move up or down on your menu until the first app highlights, and then move to the right or left to locate a button called the following: Search or Apps.
- Type in Hoopla or Hoopla Digital and hit Enter/Done.
- Download Hoopla (it should be a blue box with white hoopla lettering)

Step 3 – Adding your Hoopla Account

- Open the Hoopla App once it has finished installing.
- On your TV, you will be directed to a menu asking you to active your tv by linking an account, and will be provided a short code consisting of letters and numbers.
(Ignore the QR code shown on your screen as it will ask you to make an account outside of your library account)
- Open your phone, tablet, or computer and sign in.
- Go to your settings menu (look for a gear icon) and locate the ‘Link TV Device’ button.
- Type in the code on your phone, tablet or computer browser and hit done.
- Your TV screen should link to your account and change to show the Hoopla App with your borrowed items and other tabs on the left side of your screen. You can use these tabs to search and borrow additional items.

You're All Set!

Your TV should now show your Hoopla account screen, including:

- Items you’ve borrowed
- Categories to explore
- Options to search for new content

Use your TV remote to browse and enjoy movies, shows, audiobooks, and more – all for free with your library card!
